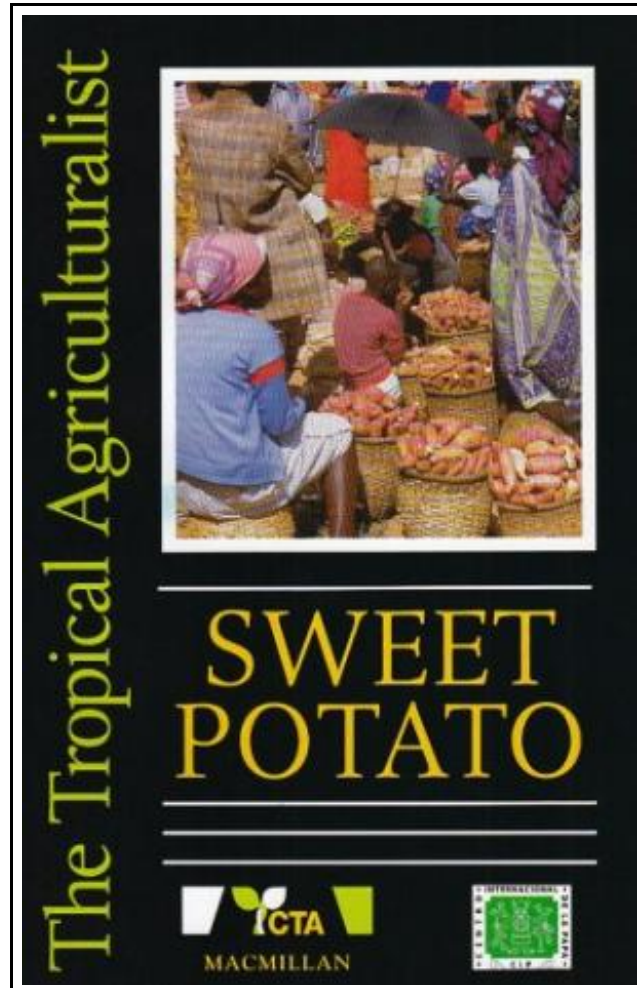

The text provides comprehensive information on the plant's growth and development, optimum conditions for cultivation, harvesting and storage, and common pests and diseases. The potential for sweet potato as a source of food security and income generation is also explored.
