

The above acts contain nothing to d-istinguish them as labor laws, other than their prime purpose to protect immigrants, the great mass of whom belong to the labor class. But chapter 514 of the acts of 1910, which is the fourth of the group dealing with immigration and recommended by the commission, in the character of its provisions appears as a distinctively labor law and contemplates state action along somewhat new and constructive lines. This law provides for a new Bureau of Industries and Immigration in the Department of Labor, in charge of a chief investigator, and to be manned by not more than twelve special investigators. The powers and duties of t-his bureau are specified at length in the law, but summed up they amount practically to the following: As to subjects or matters within its purview there is almost no limit, so long as such matters concern the welfare of aliens. As to powers, however, the bureau is limited almost entirely to investigation or inspection, with report or...
